Transport Information

Free home to school transport will be provided for students where Stour Valley Community School is the nearest school by road and provided that students live three miles or more from the school or less if there is no safe walking route.

If you live in Suffolk, please contact Suffolk On Board in the first instance to see if your child is eligible for free home to school transport – www.suffolkonboard.com or 0345 606 6173.

If your child is **not** entitled to free home to school transport from Suffolk County Council you will need to contact Hedingham and Chambers, 01787 375360 to see if they can add you to one of their routes. They will advise you of the payment plan and cost.

For those students that live in Haverhill and cannot get assistance with transport, Star Travel offer a very competitive daily rate which is to be paid on a “pay as you go” basis (01440 712712/07758 129116 for more information).

If you live in Essex, please contact Essex County Council in the first instance to see if your child is eligible for free home to school transport – [www.essex.gov.uk/contact@essex.gov.uk/0345 603 2200](http://www.essex.gov.uk/contact@essex.gov.uk/03456032200).

If your child is **not** entitled to free home to school transport from Essex County Council you will need to contact De Vere Cars, 01787 460999 to see if they can add you to one of their routes. De Vere will advise you of the payment plan and cost.

Please note that it is the responsibility of parents to ensure their child has transport to school.

We would advise that you make arrangements for your child’s transport as soon as their place at Stour Valley is confirmed.
