



Summary of 2017 Examination Performance Measures

The following data outlines the key performance indicators following the Summer 2017 examinations. In 2017, the reformed GCSEs in English and Maths were graded using a 9-1 scale, with 9 being the highest grade. Other subjects were graded using A*-G, with the following results being a combination of both measures.
