Year 10 & 11 A Christmas Carol Viewing Opportunity

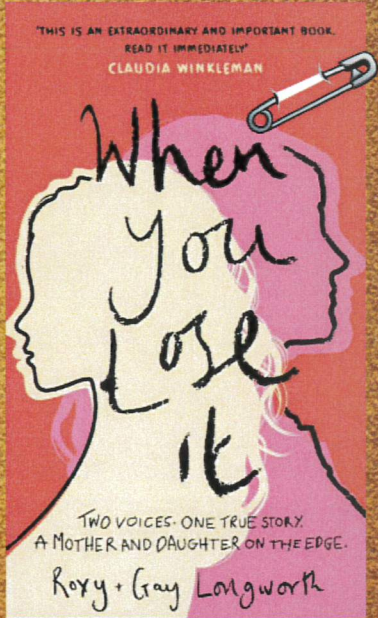
