Ticket Price Notice from Hedingham Chambers

Message from the Strategy Co-Ordinator:

Like many other commercial businesses, we are having to increase our prices from Monday 30 October 2023 because of rising costs. Until 31 December 2023 we will continue to participate in the government's £2 single ticket cap scheme, however, this does not apply to services which operate on schooldaysonly. We hope to participate in the scheme in 2024 but are awaiting funding allocation.

These amendments will mean:

- On-bus weekly tickets will increase
- App tickets will increase and be in line with on-bus tickets
- Savings are still available on the App through 30 day/subscription tickets and carnet 'bundle' tickets
